Classes looked at the history, geography, art, foods and languages from these countries. The student interaction and participation coming from classrooms, be it in school or online, was incredible.















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
















# GIS STUDENTS ELECT REPRESENTATIVES Prefects Girls Section **TO THE SCHOOL COUNCIL**
